What is being proposed?

The application requests relief from Section 4, "Residential Type 1 (R1) Zone", of Comprehensive Zoning By-law 2003-60, as amended.

Specifically, the applicant requests relief from:

 Section 4.3.9 – to permit an increased lot coverage of 45.1%, whereas the maximum lot coverage is 35% for all buildings and structures.


The variance requested would recognize the existing 18.6 square metre (200.2 sq. ft.) shed in the rear yard, and permit the construction of a new 193.2 sq. m. (2079.58 sq. ft.) single-detached dwelling with a 39.9 sq. m. (429.48 sq.

ft.) covered deck located in the rear yard.


Why Am I Receiving This Notice?
