A By-law to appoint an Acting Chief Building Official for the Town of Wasaga Beach

WHEREAS section 3(2) of the Building Code *Act*, S.O. 1992, c. 23, (Act) requires that a Council of a municipality appoint a Chief Building Official for the enforcement of the Act in areas in which the municipality has jurisdiction;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of the *Police Services Act, R.S.O. 1990, cP.15*, as amended, the Council of any municipality may appoint one or more Municipal Law Enforcement Officers who shall be Peace Officers for the purpose of enforcing the By-laws of the Municipality;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to *The Fire Protection and Prevention Act*, as amended, provides that a municipality may appoint officers to enforce By-Laws passed pursuant to the said Act;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Wasaga Beach considers it desirable to appoint an Acting Chief Building Official for the purposes of enforcing the Building Code Act, Ontario Building Code and By-laws of the Municipality;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF WASAGA BEACH HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- That Adam Horton is hereby appointed as the Acting Chief Building Official for the Town of Wasaga Beach with such powers and duties as are prescribed by the Building Code Act;
- 2. That Adam Horton is hereby appointed as a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for the Town of Wasaga Beach;
- 3. That By-law 2023-81 is hereby repealed in its entirety;
- 4. That these Appointments became effective July 30, 2024;
- 5. That this by-law shall come into force and effect on the final passage thereof.
